# Every day counts

At the heart of Hospice Mid-Northland is making every day count for those affected by life limiting illnesses.

We provide palliative care when there is no curative option available. Our services are for people with any life-limiting illness, which may include heart failure, renal failure, cancer, motor neurone disease, emphysema or other illnesses for which there is no cure. Our care is not limited to end-of-life and, with many patients, a longer-term relationship can develop over months following your diagnosis.

This includes management of our patient's pain and other symptoms, as well as engaging in conversations of honesty, truth and courageousness with patients and their whanau, their families.

We work closely with our patients and their families/whanau to enable our patients to continue to live with meaning and purpose in their lives.



## Why pay for a day?

You might want to recognize an important birthday or anniversary. Celebrate the memory of a relative or friend.

Whatever your reason, we're very grateful for your support, so thank you. It will help us to continue to providing outstanding care and support to people in your local community.

It costs \$1985 to provide our clinical services for 24 hours, or \$397 for just one nurse. By supporting a day's care, you can help patient's during what is a most challenging and difficult time for them, and make sure them and their families/whanau receive all the support they need.
